Eco-Schools Topic:

Water

Aim:

To reduce our water wastage at lunch times

Action(s):

- Stop using water in jugs/ cups at lunch time
- Replace with class water bottles

How long will it take?

Half a term

Who is responsible?

All Eco-Team members
Mr Wardman- water meter readings

How we will monitor progress:

- Observe water use at lunch times
- Check water meter readings and compare with last year

Evaluation:

- We are not throwing away 2 buckets of water at the end of lunch time any more. Less water is thrown away at the end of the day in classrooms too.

Eco-Schools Topic:

Travel

Aim:

To reduce the number of people travelling to school by car

Action(s):

- Start to use Travel Tracker
- Provide a map for Park & Stride
- Reward children who use active travel methods at least once a week, every week

How long will it take?

One term

Who is responsible?

How we will monitor progress:

- Travel Tracker every month

Evaluation:

- After one term, car use has gone down by 4%. Active travel has gone up from 73.4% to 80%.

Energy

Aim:

To encourage all classrooms to Turn It Off

Action(s):

- Re-launch Eco-Monitoring
- Information to each class
- Promote in assembly
